SPINNING



India today is one of the largest producers of cotton and blended yarn in the world. It boasts of latest technology, state of the art machinery and best work practices. The yarn from India is exported all over the world. However, the variables in spinning starting from raw material, machine parameters, operating conditions and sequential stages of manufacturing make it a complex area to handle and pose a tremendous challenge even to the veteran spinners. Diagnosis of problem and implementation of solution both call for a high level of skill set from the staff.

We offer a range of services to Spinning Industry starting from raw material suitability for a given count to waste control to productivity improvement.

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WEAVING



India has a wide variety of looms starting from hand looms to power looms to super high speed shuttle less looms. The trend obviously is more and more towards shuttle less looms entering the Industry.

n stark contrast to other looms, in case of shuttle less looms the production is limited by yarn quality specially so for cotton and blended yarn. This calls for a very careful preparation of warp beam in preparatory. Similarly, the weft has to take very high tension and needs judicious settings on loom. So the skill set to handle high speed looms are totally different compared to other looms. Many in the Industry suffer from low loom shed efficiency at 75 to 80 %.

- Analysis of loss of efficiency and measures for improvement
- Systems of quality monitoring in weaving preparatory
- Reports of production, diagnosis of low production and its improvement
- Manpower assessment and job allocation for workers
- yarn quality requirement for achieving excellence in loom shed performance

PROCESSING



India has a well developed and booming garment Industry. This needs a range of fabrics like sheeting, piece dyed shirting, light weight dress materials, denims etc. A large number of modern processing units have come up to cater to these needs. The processing area is the latest to be modernised among spinning, weaving and processing in India. There is large scope to improve production as well as product quality and its consistency.

While a process house can be set up with latest machinery with in a year, establishing quality and systems takes 3 to 4 years. This leads to severe financial burden on the new set up. This is where TPI can help to minimise the settling down time.


